

Session Four



- Needed for this session: 8.5"x11 sheet of paper and pen/pencil

Activity

- Gather your group (open with prayer for open eyes to the people God has placed around them).
- One side of your paper draw what you consider "your neighborhood", using street names, and or landmarks. Be sure it is an area you could walk within 20 minutes!
- Write the names of people you now know after this four-week journey.
- On your map, put a box where neighbors live whom you know [by name].

Teaching (VIDEO FOUR)— "Become the Lighthouse"

Dig Deeper for the week

- Read Matthew 5:13-16 – How are you living this out in this world so hostile to the hope of Jesus? How must this verse apply to your neighborhood before ever thinking about a "missions trip" elsewhere?
- Talk about the hurdles (even private excuses) you personally face when challenged to meet your neighbors...
- How many "languages" are represented in your neighborhoods? How many were born outside the U.S., and what brought them to your neighborhood?
- Who are the other believers you have identified? How open would they be to partnering in prayer for your neighbors?
- Talk about the gathering you had (or are planning)... How did it go? Who came?
- Plan to study something that takes this conversation deeper! In January Crescent Project will have another FREE small group experience available for you to try!

End in Prayer—

- Get into groups of two or three, and simply ask "How can I pray for you?" Then pray for that need. Do this until all get to pray and are prayed over.
