
ASSEMBLE YOUR PRAYER FORCE

Begin now to assemble your "prayer force" -- a small, select group of friends

- People who will hold you up in prayer as you make preparation
- Those who prayerfully anticipate your face-to-face meetings
- People with whom you could share your experiences
- Friends who could go with you in prayer walking and connecting with key leaders

A QUICK GUIDE TO PRAYER WALKING

WHAT IS PRAYER WALKING?

Praying on-site with God's insight

- Awareness by eyesight
- Discernment by revelation
- Understanding by research

Praying nearer to pray intentionally "dearer"

• Open our minds and hearts to the spiritual needs of those we are praying for

HOW TO PRAYER WALK

Before:

- Confess and repent of personal sin
- Praise, worship and read Scripture
- Pray for spiritual protection (Eph 6)
- Research the community

During:

- Form a team (2-3 people)
- Walk and pray
- Don't draw attention to yourself

In Agreement:

- Pray using God's word and scriptures
- Pray with relevance (what we see and hear)
- Pray with faith (beyond what we see)

After:

• Debrief as a group

WHAT TO PRAY FOR

- God's blessings upon the community (Matthew 5:3-10)
- God would reveal who Jesus is and that only He can deliver from sin and its consequences (John 14:6)
- God would lift the darkness and deception over these people (1 Timothy 2:4-6)
- God's kingdom would come to this people and community as it is in Heaven and that His will be done (Matthew 6:9-13)
- Dreams and visions (Joel 2:28)
- Open doors (John 10:9)
