From its foundation, Globe International has centered its core values and organizational culture upon Christian principles, based firmly on the teachings of the Bible. Globe International was established to equip and resource those who are called by God for global and evangelistic ministry. Globe functions to assist the Body of Christ in achieving the Great Commission of Jesus Christ by aiding God's sent people who are carrying the Gospel around the world.













Further, Globe International endeavors to help churches and ministries to serve their communities, domestically and internationally. Directed by our Core Values of Faith, Service, and Mercy, Globe's slogan reflects our commitment to "Making Disciples - Planting Churches - Reaching Nations."

International Globe and the Globe Network currently serve missionary and evangelistic ministers in 48 countries. The Globe Network is comprised of six interconnected that send agencies missionaries from the United States, Germany, Switzerland, United Kingdom, Brazil, and Mexico. The Network offers ministerial and administrative services to network members.

Globe International partners with over 500 churches from multiple denominations and affiliations. GLOBE INTERNATIONAL HISTORY & FUTURE

Globe International was founded in 1973 by the Rev. Ken Sumrall. Sumrall spent some of his early years in the ministry sharing the Gospel in Asia, Africa, Europe, and Latin America. His burden to train and send missionaries led to the formation of a Bible college and Globe International to establish and resource mission personnel.

Bob Bishop became Globe's first General Director, serving from 1976 until 2004. Doug Gehman joined the Globe staff as Assistant Director in 1994 and became Director in 2001 and President in 2004. A Board of Directors comprised of pastors, business people, and the Executive Director, govern the affairs of Globe International.

Now as an inter-denominational agency, Globe has grown to assist diversified and unique ministries throughout the United States and around the world. Thousands of individuals and hundreds of churches regularly give to the outreach activities and ministries associated with Globe.

with Globe's Frontiers Initiative and the child safety
program.

Bob & Melissa Hill Directors of Member Care

Bob and Melissa and their young family moved to Japan in 1985 with the purpose of evangelization and establishing churches. They

established two churches in Japan, then in 1995, the Hills moved to Scotland with the same purpose. Along with building the church in Scotland, Bob and Melissa acquired a small castle and now oversee a ministry to young women fleeing sexual exploitation. Bob and Melissa are also Directors of Member Care on the Globe Leadership team and oversee Member Care Reps to assist our missionaries across the globe. The Hill's three children and seven grandchildren are scattered from Scotland to the US.

Scott Brown Director of Development

As the Director of Development, Scott fosters cohesive relationships between Globe missionaries, partnering churches

and like-minded organizations for greater ministry opportunities, creative resourcing, and strategic training. Scott also functions as an emissary for Globe and Globe missionaries, advocating for strategic global training, sending, and serving of Globe members. Scott has been associated with Globe International for most of his adult life. Scott served as Globe's office manager from 2006 to 2009. Previously he served as the Executive Director for Dick Reuben Evangelistic Association, as th Dean of Students for the Brownsville Revival School of Ministy, and as the Missions Pastor for Liberty Church. Scott founded the Mordecai Brown Legacy Foundation in 2003, which he later brought to Globe International as a strategic sports ministry outreach.

Greg Nemer Director of Disciple Making

Greg Nemer along with his family have served the nation of Mexico since 1989 where they functioned as evangelists and church planters. Their Mexican ministry has over 200 Churches under its spiritual covering. They also assisted in the formation of Misión Global missions sending agency.

Today, Greg provides a link to Globe's nearly two hundred missionaries, and new candidates, offering coaching and training towards Disciple Making and Church Planting. Greg has a particular burden for Southeast Asia's unreached people groups (UPG's). His personal goal is to plant 5000 simple churches among unreached peoples before 2025.





CONNECTING YOU & THE CHURCH TO THE WORLD

As a faith-based mission agency, Globe partners with churches in the work of sending and sustaining missionaries on every continent around the world. Globe helps provide spiritual oversight and strategic guidance to improve effectiveness, assistance in the fundraising aspects of mission, and a solid base for mission work.

Globe functions in partnership with the church to help fulfill the church's missionary vision. Pastors and church leaders are expected to be involved with the missionaries and ministers they send through Globe and are encouraged to visit the field and actively participate in spiritual care and communication.

Globe International is focused on reaching people for Jesus Christ and helping them become responsible, growing, contributing, outreaching members of indigenous churches all over the world. All of Globe's mission activities, including our training programs, are designed to empower Christians to advance the Gospel. Even humanitarian ministry to the poor must be done within this larger framework - to empower people to follow Jesus within the context of their native culture.



FRONTIERS INITIATIVE

GOAL: Within ten years our focus "Unreached People Groups" will have a viable indigenous church that is strong enough to reach their own people.

STRATEGY: To immediately recruit, train and send new Christ-followers and church planters to our focus unreached people groups with the five-year goal to plant a viable, indigenous church planting movement in each one.

HOW TO ENGAGE:

- 1. Join or form a "Research & Identify Cohort" to help find focus unreached people groups
- 2. Join or form a "Go Team" to engage an unreached people group on a five-year mission
- 3. Join or form an "Advocacy Group" to support Go Team partnerships

RESEARCH AND IDENTIFY COHORT

- a. Build a team to assist us in researching potential unreached people groups for our focus
- b. Using available unreached people group information, the team will filter data through six criteria:



Population is greater than 50,000



Have less than 2% Christ followers



Have the Bible in their heart language



Demonstrate high receptivity





GLOBE'S HUB CITY STRATEGY



As part of Globe's Unreached People Group Initiative, Orlando, FL, Jacksonville, FL, Minneapolis, MN, Chicago, IL, New York City, Los Angeles, CA, San Francisco, CA and Clarkston, GA (Atlanta suburb) have been identified as Globe International HUB Cities. HUB Cities are metropolitan areas hosting sizable populations of Least Reached Peoples living in or near these cities.

A HUB City offers increasing connectivity and opportunity to impact international populations with the Gospel. HUB Cities are enlisted as a training ground for immersion ministry among international peoples, to export the Gospel to their home countries around the world.

Modern immigration symbolizes a new era in missions—one in which the magnitude of today's migration, globalization, and urbanization pose unprecedented opportunities to take the Gospel to the ends of the earth through the people who live in HUB Cities.

Globe acknowledges this bouquet of the nations in the United States as a Kingdom opportunity. Our end goal, reflected in Revelation 7:9, is to see "many multitudes which were impossible to count, which were of all people, generations, nations and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb."



LAUNCHING OUT

EXPLORING AND NAVIGATING YOUR CALL TO THE WORLD

The task of local and global evangelization was given to the people of God. It was from the church at Antioch that the Holy Spirit sent out the first mission personnel (Acts 13:1-4). We are persuaded that the scriptural New Testament pattern for evangelization is for the local church to send mission personnel to preach the Gospel, plant indigenous churches, teach disciples to obey the Word of God, and evangelize others in their own ethnic or language group.

By joining Globe International, missionaries and evangelistic ministries become a part of a growing team that serves God all over the world. Globe members join hands in a partnership with God's people on mission as goers and senders, including hundreds of churches and thousands of supporters who send laborers to the world in Jesus' name.



Globe offers each new candidate the opportunity to enter into a partnership that thoughtfully and prayerfully sets a strategic course in pursuing God's call. Globe helps plan the path for those just getting started on their mission and also those who have experience and already know where they are heading.

To facilitate service and resourcing for many kinds of missionaries and ministries, Globe has three Missionary Categories:

- 1) Intern Assignment [SD or FX] Missionaries or ministers who are new to Globe and plan to serve for three months to three years. Short Duration: 1-12 months. Full Experience: 1-3 years. Go Team: Join or form a "Go Team" to engage a UPG on a five-year mission
- 2) Commissioned Assignment (CO) Interns who are ready to take the next step towards a possible career in missions.
- 3) Career Assignment (CA) missionaries and evangelists with a proven call and long-term commitment to cross-cultural work.

Each membership category receives the full scope of Globe International's services and staff support.
