Who is this for?

The Global Ambassador Program is a 9-month program that creates a meaningful way for recent college graduates to grow in their calling to impact the nations while living in an intentional, like-minded community.

We're looking for people who:

- ✓ Desire to join a team of courageous world-changers.
- ✓ Desire to be mentored and grow their perspective.
- ✓ Desire to serve in community.
- ✓ Demonstrate strong character, humility, and integrity.



When and where is it?

The Global Ambassador Program takes place from September through late May in Chiang Mai, Thailand or Tunis, Tunisia. The program also includes travel to nearby countries to provide a taste of other cultures and see ways to impact local communities.

What should participants expect?


Participants should expect to grow both personally and professionally through this nine-month experience. This is an investment in their future. A few opportunities for growth include:

- ✓ Receiving a professional TEFL or CELTA certification.
- ✓ Deepening their knowledge and understanding of our hope and its impact on their view of the world and others.
- ✓ Completing other courses that will grow their understanding of cross-cultural work.
- Receiving intentional mentorship to increase confidence and leadership abilities.
- ✓ Adopting a new skill set for navigating culture and grasping language.

How much does it cost and what's included?

The total cost is approx. \$29,000—\$32,000.

This total is an estimate that will be finalized once your custom budget is created with our team. Your budget will include housing, a monthly spending allowance, international airfare, training, and more.

What will a typical week look like?

A typical week includes language learning (Thai or Arabic), time with a mentor, team meetings, teaching, investing in relationships within the local community, and training to build strong foundations in cross-cultural living and leadership.

What does mentorship look like?

Participants will receive ongoing, personal and professional mentorship from both experienced leaders and their own peer community. GAP leaders are intentionally chosen and represent decades of cross-cultural experience. Through weekly meetings, they will aim to help GAPers navigate the various questions and tensions of serving overseas.

Do I have to pay the program cost out of pocket?

Not necessarily! While that is an option, we encourage you to raise support for the cost of the program and will equip you to do so. We've found that support-raising can be formational, and that the local Body would love to partner with you in this journey!

Where will I live and how will I get around?

The program takes place in Chiang Mai, Thailand or Tunis, Tunisia (Southeast Asia or North Africa). Participants will live in shared homes of the same gender in order to strengthen team community. Both cities are easy to navigate by taxi, tuktuk, and bicycle.

How much teaching is involved?

The specifics will vary by program year and location. GAPers will contribute in a variety of ways that may include local school systems, refugee populations, youth camps, language centers, and other local partnerships.

What will other regional travel look like?

Factored into the total cost are two trips to participate in teaching opportunities and visit local workers in surrounding areas and countries. These opportunities give our participants a chance to put into practice what they have been learning on a daily basis. Beyond the practical value of offering local English camps, GAPers will also be exposed to new cultures and get a first-hand look at life on the ground for long-term workers.
